Participant Behaviors (to be handed out):

You move slowly and get distracted easily unless you are given clear instructions.

You respond well to cheering and encouragement, but shut down when spoken to sternly.

You can't use your left arm well, but you don't want to tell anyone. You hope someone will notice and help you.

You are a new Israeli camper, and you still have trouble understanding instructions given in English. (No need to speak Hebrew.)

You had a traumatic experience when camping as a young child, and as a result, refuse to enter anything that looks like a tent.

You are super competitive.

You find tight spaces overwhelming. You try to avoid physical contact (even accidental) as much as possible.

When you begin any task, you ask lots of questions. You like to understand how things work fully before diving in and beginning.

You find rules frustrating, and would rather find your own way to do the task. You are committed to following the rules as closely as possible.

You feel overwhelmed by the number of steps in the task, and wait to be invited to participate in the activity.

You prefer to let other people take the lead.

You just want everyone to get along.
