Experience Guidelines

- In threes,
 - **Role 1** thinks of any verb, adjective, or noun.
 - **Role 2** rhymes with or alliterates with the word.
 - **Role 3** puts the two words together (in either order) and defines the new term
- Once you are...
 - **Role 1 Role 2**
 - **Role 2 Role 3**
 - **Role 3 Role 1**
- Example:
 - **Role 1: *Toaster***
 - **Role 2: *Tactical***
 - **Role 3: *The ole' Tactical Toaster was a World War 1 battery powered toaster given to soldiers for a breakfast on the go option. The government didn't want soldiers to go without a hot carbohydrate, so the Tactical toaster was born.***

Planning Your Dream Vacation!

Experience Guidelines

- Imagine you are living in a Post-COVID world and finally get to travel again.
- You are planning a dream vacation with some of your fellow board members!
- The vacation will be 8 days in total.
- There's no budget!
- First, you will establish your **team communication norms & expectations** in the Team Charter below
 - Plan for making decisions
 - Plan for incorporating team members' ideas
 - Plan for handling disagreements
- Then, you will collectively choose a destination and plan Days 1 & 2 of the vacation!

Example of Travel Team Charter Responses

- **Plan for making decisions:** We are going to let everyone write down or chat their ideas, then discuss which one we like best and decide via consensus.
- **Plan for being inclusive of team members' ideas:** Everyone will have a chance to share and use at least one idea from each team member somewhere in our final output.
- **Plan for handling disagreements:** Team members will be encouraged to say when they feel there is a disagreement. If this happens, we will assign a team member to mediate the disagreement and let them make the final decision.
