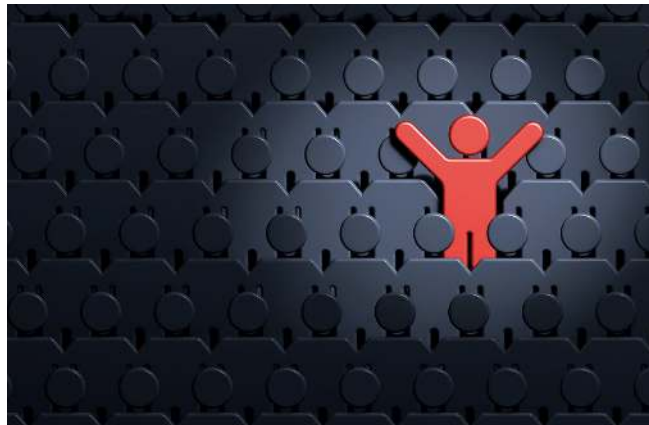

Cup 2: What Makes Us Different?

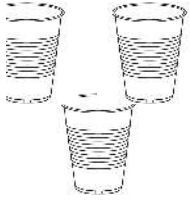
Reflect on your experience “tagging” yourself. How did you react toward others? How did others react toward you? What did you notice? Write or doodle here:

Cup 3: Finding the Afikomen

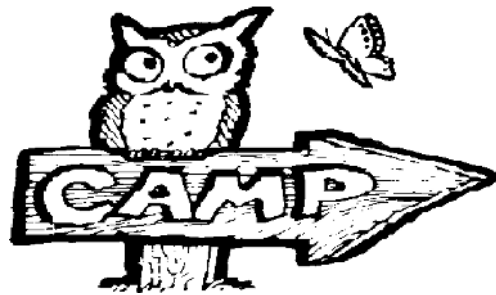
Where did you find your afikomen? How did you pick it up and bring it to the table? Who else was involved in the process? Write or doodle about your experience here:
