SESSION DESCRIPTION:

Are you a leader and or a teacher? Do you engage in processing discussions with your groups to help them learn? Do you find yourself helping others through conflict? Are you good at asking questions, but want to get better? In this processing workshop, you will have the opportunity to work through and learn the Open to Outcome model of questioning. With a progression of just five questions, you can build empathy within diverse groups, help them open up and listen to each other, get them to consider the “other” point of view, and be willing to change behaviors that will enhance their positive interactions with each other. The Open to Outcome model is easy to learn and implement and can be used with groups of all ages. All leadership and facilitation ability levels are welcome to join.

BIG IDEAS FROM THIS SESSION:

Did you notice...? Or, What did you notice during the activity?

Why did that happen? Or, Why do you think that happened?

Does this happen...(e.g., at camp, at work, during school, with your family)?

Who? What? Where? When? Why? (Share an example of this happening - in relation to one of the 5 Ws)

What will you do now? Or, How can you use this information in the future?
