You don't need a lot of elaborate props to team build, you want a clear purpose and an activity that will make the point.

The same team building activity can be used at all levels of an organization - change in purpose to make it work for the roles and responsibilities of each group. You don't need a long list of activities.

Activities don't need to be long to make the point - meet your purpose.

Team building can take place anywhere. Look for "in-the-moment" experiences/events that have an obvious learning lesson. You don't have to "lead" a team building activity to develop your team.
