This scene at camp might look like a “Lost & Found,” but it is intentionally filled with symbols for ways you might show up at camp—and in life. Any item on the poster can be symbolic! Here are just a few ideas...

- visionary** (telescope icon): dreaming big & providing a clear path forward
- teammate** (basketball icon): sharing responsibilities to accomplish a shared win
- doctor** (stethoscope icon): diagnosing problems & providing long-term care, not just simple bandages
- artist** (easel icon): incorporating beauty to introduce new perspectives & evoke feelings in others
- storyteller** (book icon): sharing history & context to situations, making sense of life, relating to others, & valuing truth
- fixer** (red toolbox icon): seeing a problem & eliminating it
- caretaker** (trash can icon): sticking around to pick up the pieces & assess which can be recycled or reused
- coach** (clipboard icon): encouraging others to achieve their best results
- referee** (whistle icon): mediating different players, ensuring everyone follows the rules
- guide** (paddle icon): taking everything in stride to steer others in the right direction
- reflective listener** (wooden chair icon): sharing for others, asking good questions & being present
- first responder** (fire extinguisher icon): putting out fires & staying calm, managing crises as they arise
