### Q&A: A Living Document

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#### Health and Safety

**Q:** Under what Covid-circumstances will you, FJC, choose not to operate the in-person event?

**A:** We'll cancel and move to a virtual kick-off with sufficient notice if the weather forces us to. We'll plan a rain or shine outdoor event, but in the event of heavy thunderstorms for example, we'll move virtual. We will NOT take the event indoors under any circumstances. We are deciding upon an infection rate threshold at which we will also plan to cancel.

**Q:** What Covid safety measures will you take for the kick-off event?

**A:** We will adhere to all DOH and CDC guidelines and recommendations including required masking, social distancing between pods (teens from one camp) and other pods (teens from other camps), and pods and educators and other FJC staff, as well as proper cleaning and sanitizing.

#### Transportation

**Q:** How will my teens get to HKC Long Island?

**A:** For this event, we are asking camps to arrange for their own transportation and to send us the bill for reimbursement. You can arrange for your bus company to bring the teens to HKC, or for them to be driven. Bus parking will be available, with limited spots for cars.

#### Money

**Q:** What does it cost to participate?

**A:** Nothing! Just a little bit of staff time from you and others to pull it all together. As always, we will provide modest stipends to teens for participation, and for adult chaperones aka liaisons from your camp to join them at the kick-off and at Tzedek Tzircles.
