

Creation-Themed Scavenger Hunt



Overview:

Shabbat is deeply intertwined with the Biblical story of creation. In the story, God creates the world in six days, and then on the seventh, takes a day of Shabbat/rest to appreciate the beauty of creation.

This Shabbat/creation-themed scavenger hunt highlights the creation story and invites families to take a closer look at their surroundings. This can be a group activity, or something for families to do on their own.

Supplies:

- Copy of <u>Creation Scavenger Hunt</u> handout from PJ Library
- Optional: magnifying hand-lens, binoculars, clipboards
- Optional: Story of creation (can be shared through <u>the original text</u>, a picture book, or a song, such as <u>The Creation Song</u> by *Josh and the Jamtones*)

Instructions

- Review the days of creation through story or song
- Pass out the scavenger hunt choose a time to regroup if you want an opportunity for families to share
- If regrouping, invite families to share what they found
