



POCKET GUIDE PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

1 Add your logo to the footer in Word

- Open your document and double-click in the footer area (or go to **Insert** → **Footer** → **Edit Footer**).
- With the footer active, click on the FJC logo until it shows a box around the logo and then **right click** the logo and select **Change Picture...** to select your camp's logo



- Click the logo to resize (drag a corner handle) and position it (set text wrap to "In Front of Text" if needed).
- When it looks right, click **Close Header and Footer** (or double-click outside).

2 Save the document as a PDF

- Go to **File** → **Save As** (or **File** → **Export** → **Create PDF/XPS**).
- In "Save as type," pick **PDF (*.pdf)**.
- Then click **Save** (or **Publish**).

3 On your windows computer, open the PDF and print as a booklet in Adobe Acrobat Reader

- **Download Adobe Reader here:** <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
- Launch **Adobe Acrobat Reader DC**, then **File** → **Open** your PDF.
- Go to **File** → **Print**, and under **Page Sizing & Handling** select **Booklet**.
- Choose **Both sides** (for duplex printers) or manually select **Front side only** then **Back side only** on a second pass.
- Set **Binding: Left**, confirm your printer, and click **Print**.

(See reverse side for printing instructions on Apple computers.)

1 On your Mac, **open your PDF in Preview**

- In Finder, double-click your PDF to launch it in Preview (the default PDF viewer on Mac).

2 **Open the Print dialog**

- Choose **File** → **Print...** or press **⌘ P**.
- If you see only a simplified dialog, click **Show Details** to expand all options.

3 **Enable booklet layout**

In the expanded Print dialog, locate the section chooser (it may default to “Preview” or “Copies & Pages”). Click it and select **Layout**.

- You should now see a **Booklet** checkbox—check it to turn on booklet imposition.
- Under **Two-Sided**, pick **Short-Edge binding** (for English-style fold) if your printer does duplex automatically. If it doesn't, pick **Off**, print the “Front side only,” then flip the stack per your printer's instructions, reopen Print, choose **Back side only**, and print the reverse side manually.
